

CloudHealth Permissions Comparison (Azure)

For best results, all Azure Enrollment Agreements, Service Principals, and Subscriptions should appear as “Healthy” within CloudHealth*

Azure Billing information only

- ✓ Cost and usage data
- ✓ Cost allocation tags only

⚠ Accounts will appear in **Critical** or **Unconfigured** status

Azure Billing information + Reader Role added to Service Principal (Recommended)

- ✓ Cost and usage data
- ✓ Cost allocation tags
- ✓ Asset-level metadata, including tags not in the billing information
- ✓ Reserved Instance (RI) inventory for better recommendations

Azure Billing information + Contributor Role added to Service Principal (Preferred)

- ✓ Cost and usage data
- ✓ Cost allocation tags
- ✓ Asset-level metadata, including tags not in the CUR
- ✓ Reserved Instance (RI) inventory for better recommendations
- ✓ Customizable actions, such as
 - Starting Virtual Machines
 - Restarting Virtual Machines
 - Stopping & Deallocating Virtual Machines
 - Rightsizing Virtual Machines

* Enrollment Agreement, Service Principal, and Subscription permissions should be configured to reflect “Healthy” status within CloudHealth
